Materials

To crochet a sunflower granny square, you will need the following materials:

- * Worsted weight yarn in yellow, brown, and green
- * Crochet hook size H (5.00mm)
- * Yarn needle

Abbreviations

* ch = chain * sc = single crochet * dc = double crochet * tr = treble crochet

* sl st = slip stitch

Pattern

Round 1: Ch 4, join with a sl st to form a ring.

Round 2: Ch 3 (counts as a dc), *dc in ring, ch 1*; repeat * around, join with a sl st to the top of ch 3. (12 dc)

Round 3: Ch 3 (counts as a dc), *dc in ch-1 space, ch 2, dc in next ch-1 space*; repeat * around, join with a sl st to the top of ch 3. (12 dc, 12 ch-2 spaces)

Round 4: Ch 3 (counts as a dc), *dc in ch-2 space, ch 1, 2 dc in next ch-2 space*; repeat * around, join with a sl st to the top of ch 3. (24 dc, 12 ch-1 spaces)

Round 5: Ch 3 (counts as a dc), *dc in ch-1 space, ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-1 space*; repeat * around, join with a sl st to the top of ch 3. (36 dc, 12 ch-2 spaces)

Round 6: Ch 3 (counts as a dc), *dc in ch-2 space, ch 1, 4 dc in next ch-2 space*; repeat * around, join with a sl st to the top of ch 3. (48 dc, 12 ch-1 spaces)

Round 7: Change to brown yarn. Ch 3 (counts as a dc), *dc in ch-1 space, ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-1 space*; repeat * around, join with a sl st to the top of ch 3. (60 dc, 12 ch-2 spaces)

Round 8: Ch 3 (counts as a dc), *dc in ch-2 space, ch 1, 6 dc in next ch-2 space*; repeat * around, join with a sl st to the top of ch 3. (72 dc, 12 ch-1 spaces)

Round 9: Change to green yarn. Ch 3 (counts as a dc), *dc in ch-1 space, ch 2, 7 dc in next ch-1 space*; repeat * around, join with a sl st to the top of ch 3. (84 dc, 12 ch-2 spaces)

Round 10: Ch 3 (counts as a dc), *dc in ch-2 space, ch 1, 8 dc in next ch-2 space*; repeat * around, join with a sl st to the top of ch 3. (96 dc, 12 ch-1 spaces)

Round 11: Ch 3 (counts as a dc), *dc in ch-1 space, ch 2, 9 dc in next ch-1 space*; repeat * around, join with a sl st to the top of ch 3. (108 dc, 12 ch-2 spaces)

Round 12: Fasten off and weave in loose ends.

Congratulations! You have now crocheted a beautiful sunflower granny square. This granny square is perfect for blankets, afghans, and other home décor projects. You can also use this granny square to create a variety of other items, such as hats, scarves, and coasters.




