
# **Lumbar Spondylolisthesis: An Issue of Neurosurgery Clinics of North America**



#### What is lumbar spondylolisthesis?

Lumbar spondylolisthesis is a condition in which one vertebra slips forward over the vertebra below it. This can occur at any level of the lumbar spine,

but it is most common at the L5-S1 level (the lowest level of the lumbar spine).

Spondylolisthesis is classified into five grades, based on the degree of slippage:

\* Grade I: The vertebra slips forward by less than 25%. \* Grade II: The vertebra slips forward by 25-50%. \* Grade III: The vertebra slips forward by 50-75%. \* Grade IV: The vertebra slips forward by 75-100%. \* Grade V: The vertebra slips forward by more than 100%.
