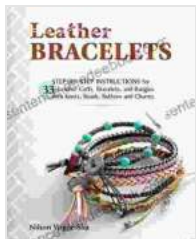

Bangle 2: Japanese Kumihimo Bangle

3. Divide the strands into four groups of two.
4. Braid each group of two strands using the Kumihimo braiding technique.

Cuff 3: Beaded Leather Cuff

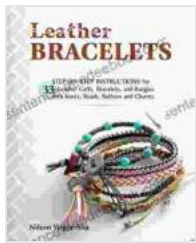

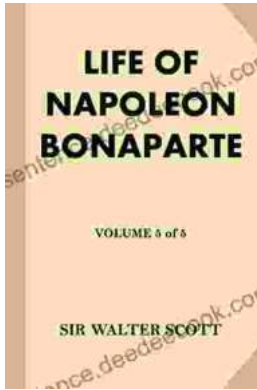
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
